



**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION
for the Master of Specialties in Health and Drug Sciences,
Academic year 2024 – 2025**

The President of the Université Joseph KI-ZERBO would like to inform French and English-speaking students and the general public that, for the academic year **2024 – 2025**, a call for applications has been launched for enrolment in the Master of Specialties in Health and Drug Sciences. This training is offered by the Center for Training, Research and Expertise in Drug Sciences (CEA-CFOREM) located at the Training and Research Unit in Health Sciences (UFR/SDS) and the Doctoral School of Sciences and Health (ED2S).

CEA-CFOREM is a regionalization center supported by the Association of African Universities and the World Bank, within the framework of the African Centers of Excellence for Impact (CEA-Impact) projects.

The following options are open for the **2024 - 2025** academic year:

1. Biopharmacy, Pharmaceutical Formulation and Engineering;
2. Dermopharmacy and Cosmetology;
3. Pharmaceutical supply management and health logistics;
4. Pharmacology and clinical pharmacy;
5. Hospital Pharmacy;
6. Pharmaceutical regulation;
7. Toxicology.

May be authorized to register for the Master:

1. For both Professional and Research Orientation:

- Holders of a doctorate in pharmacy (State Diploma);
- Residents of hospitals in pharmacy admitted to the competition of Burkinabe university hospital centers;
- Pharmacy students who have validated semester 10 of the general course of pharmacy studies;
- Holders of the diplomas of doctor, dentist and veterinarian for the following options: Dermopharmacy and cosmetology, Pharmacology and Toxicology;
- Holders of any other diploma deemed equivalent by the scientific and educational committee of the master.

2. For the Research Orientation only:

Holders of Bachelor's or Master's degrees in life and earth sciences, exact sciences, law or any other degree deemed valid by the scientific and pedagogical committee of the Master's degree, may be admitted to register for the research orientation of one of the following options: Biopharmacy, Pharmaceutical Formulation and Engineering, Dermopharmacy and cosmetology, Pharmacology, Pharmaceutical regulation, Toxicology.

The application file must include:

- A handwritten request in French or English addressed to the President of the Université Joseph KI-ZERBO specifying the option of the chosen specialty, the sources of financing for the training, the modality of teaching chosen (face-to-face or distance learning) and the preferred language of training;
- A curriculum vitae (03 pages maximum) ;
- A legalized photocopy of the birth certificate or the suppletive judgement in case thereof;
- A legalized photocopy of the certificate of nationality;
- A legalized photocopy of the diploma of Baccalaureate;
- A legalized photocopy of original diploma(s) and/or certificates required;
- A legalized photocopy of transcripts of records of Bachelor's degree (L1, L2 and L3) for the candidates for the research orientation only and Master's degree (M1 and M2) for candidates for research and professional orientation;
- An identity photo;
- A letter of motivation;

- A letter of recommendation from a member of the Center's advisory board, a university teacher, head of a research laboratory and/or head of a health service or program would be an asset;
- A written agreement from the applicant's administrative authority for participation in the Master's program, if applicable;
- Proof of funding agreement covering training costs, if applicable.

The complete applications are submitted online on the Campusfaso platform at the address: <https://www.campusfaso.bf> until **June 30th 2024 at Midnight 00 GMT**. To this end, candidates must go to the website at the address: <https://www.campusfaso.bf> in the application section in order to create:

- an account on the platform to obtain a national student identity number (INE);
- their application file on the platform and submit it, choosing the option they wish to pursue in the Master of health and drug sciences.

Complete applications are also received at the secretariat of the Master or CEA-CFOREM, located at the UFR/SDS (03 BP 7021 Ouagadougou 03, Tel (+226) 75 55 20 20) and/or by email to (niadasafiatou15@gmail.com, charlsombie@yahoo.fr ; mastermeduobf@gmail.com ; cea.cforem.ujkz@gmail.com), until **June 30th 2024 at Midnight 00 GMT**.

The selection of candidates is made by the Master's Pedagogical Committee. A maximum of **thirty-five (35)** candidates, including all options and orientations, may be admitted. Candidates will be individually informed of the results of the selection process no later than **July 30th, 2024**.

The selected candidates will follow a face-to-face training course on the Centre's premises. Foreign students are authorized to carry out their internships and dissertations outside Burkina Faso, under the supervision of the Centre's scientific and academic partners. For English-speaking candidates, a language immersion program will facilitate their integration into the academic process.

The annual registration and training fees for the Master of Specialties in Health and Drug Sciences (MSSM) degree are set as follows

- Annual registration fees, payable in one instalment:
 - o 16.500 F CFA for students from the UEMOA zone registered under the student regime;
 - o 51.500 F CFA for students from the UEMOA zone registered as employees;

- 251.500 F CFA for students from outside the UEMOA zone.
- Annual training fees, payable in one or two installments
 - 750.000 F CFA personal payment;
 - 1.250.000 F CFA paid by an institution.
